#### Welcome - Croeso to Year 6

#### Year 6

The children come into school at 8.55am.

If you are going to be late picking up your child at the end of the day, please call the office, so that we can reassure your child that they will be picked up.

If your child is coming into school with a mobile phone, please be aware that it will be stored in a cupboard during the day and returned to your child at 3pm.
