We had a lovely end to the half term, baking World War 2 biscuits. The children followed recipes to make honey, carrot and orange biscuits. They demonstrated super whisking, creaming and stirring techniques! Once the biscuits had been baked, we sampled each one. The honey biscuit was the most popular, with the children comparing it to gingerbread biscuits. There were mixed reactions to the carrot biscuits!

The children wrote beautiful and poignant descriptions during their Big Write session, based on an image of Rose Blanche standing alone in a war zone. They made really powerful word choices to bring the descriptions to life. The children enjoyed sharing their descriptions with each other and they gave thoughtful positive feedback.

Negative numbers have been the focus of our Math lessons this week. We have ordered and compared negative numbers, found the difference between negative numbers as well as adding and subtracting negative numbers.

During our ICT lesson we had an in-depth debate about how to stay safe on-line, including a discussion about what personal information is and why it shouldn't be shared online.
