The children continue to amaze me and this week I have been blown away by the outstanding quality of the persuasive arguments the children wrote during their Big Write session. They wrote persuasive letters to Mrs. Adams, regarding banning homework (!), having an extra playtime and having more choice with the dinner menu. We used emotive language to make our arguments even more persuasive and used the internet to research evidence and statistics to strengthen each point.

During our Maths lessons we have been focusing on percentages. The children used 10% to find other percentages, such as 20%, 60% and 5%. The children found percentages of amounts and completed a mathematical jigsaw, which they found challenging yet fun!

We have begun our enterprise learning and we were inspired by the 'no plastic' and 'natural' ideas the children had discussed with their enterprise homework. This week the children designed persuasive adverts, which we will place around school to convince others to buy their products. They also designed their snowmen, identifying the materials they want to use to make accessories such as hats and scarves. Early next week we will create the snowmen and reindeer, ready to sell on Friday.
