Welcome back – we have a very busy and exciting half-term ahead of us, with lots of extra activities including our World War 2 trip, a PTA art exhibition (details to follow), our Christmas enterprise and Christmas performances.

The children have come back to school with a fantastic focus and they are really ready to learn, which is wonderful to see. In our Maths lessons we have been focusing on fractions. We have spent time simplifying fractions, identify fractions which are in their simplest form and ordering and comparing fractions.

We spent time working in groups to brainstorm alternative endings and the children then decided on their own ending and wrote a plan. Next week they will be writing their alternate ending during Big Write.

In our topic lessons the children spent time researching the aeroplanes that were used during World War 2. This research will help the children when they begin designing their junk model aeroplanes. We have also looked at the artist 'Johnny Carroll Pell' and created our own pieces of art based on his style.
