Welcome back! Year 6 have had a wonderful first week back at school and have started the New Year full of enthusiasm and positive energy.

Our learning this week in English has focused on explanatory texts. The children have analyzed an explanation, identified the key features, have written sentences with cause and effect connectives and have improved their note taking skills. We even took part in a chocolate tasting session, as for our Big Write, the children will write an explanation of how chocolate is made.

In Maths, the children have converted imperial to metric measures as well as reading and interpreting scales on a range of measuring instruments.

Our new topic for this term is 'Frozen Kingdom'. The children have been busy locating continents and oceans, researching interesting facts about continents and finding similarities and differences about the Arctic and Antarctic and placing these on a Venn Diagram. We have also carried out a Science investigation focusing on our resting heart rate, which included writing a prediction, creating a scatter graph and drawing a scientific conclusion.
