In our topic lessons this week, the children have been constructing an Antarctic food web. They have also researched the main events of Shackleton's life on a timeline and thought about his personal qualities, including what made him a determined and courageous leader. The children then worked really hard to write lively biographies about his life.

In our Maths lessons we looked in greater depth about probability and used the probability scale. They took part in an activity where they rolled a dice 60 times and recorded the number of times the dice landed on each face. They produced a bar graph to illustrate the results and we considered why the dice didn't land on each face (1-6) 10 times. The children looked at a range of number sequences and described what was happening to the numbers in each sequence. They were then challenged to find the 10th term in each sequence – which they really enjoyed!

During our literacy lessons we have been looking at developing different poetic techniques, including personification, similes and metaphors. We read and took inspiration from 'Goodnight Stroud'. We identified objects in the school that could 'come alive' and used these objects to develop our poetic techniques. Their imaginations are exceptional and have some wonderful ideas for their final poem.
