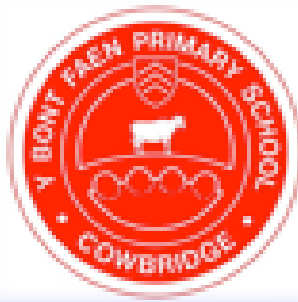
Mrs Davies's Class

On Thursday the children sat The National Reading Test. I was very impressed with their mature approach towards the test. The children have also read a text on a Victorian Workhouse, and written their own set of challenging comprehension questions for a friend to answer. They also peer assessed the questions that their friend had written.

In numeracy we have been preparing for the Maths Reasoning Test; solving a range of problems using the RUCSAC method. The children also continued with our topic of translating shapes and revisiting different number concepts. The children have also created a pie chart to show the hours worked by a Victorian maid at Cyfarthfa Castle.

In topic the children have looked at Victorian Decoupage - the art of decorating a surface with paper cut-outs that are glued on in layers. We also reflected on the value of the month; responsibility. The children have written about what responsibilities they have to themselves, at home, in school and to the wider world.

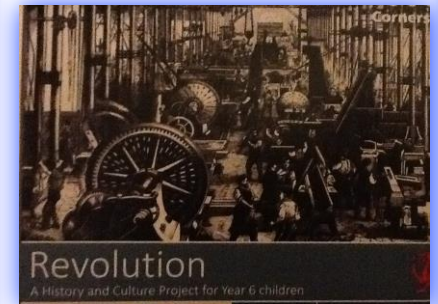
