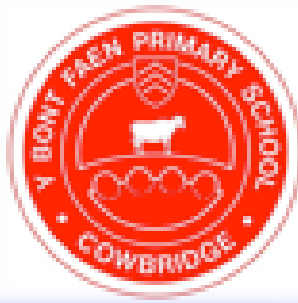
Mrs Davies's Class

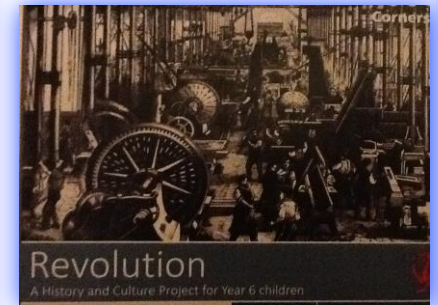
