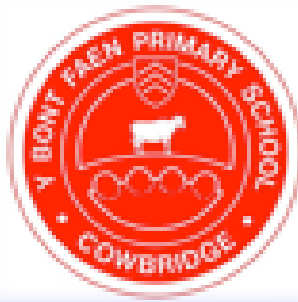
Mrs Davies's Class

In numeracy the children have been exploring a range of statements linked to odd and even numbers, and proving with examples of their own whether they are true or false. We have also revisited the bus stop method of division and have been measuring and drawing lines to the nearest millimetre.

On Thursday the class visited Southway Residential Home and shared their learning with the residents. I was really impressed with their behaviour and level of maturity.
